2:00-5:00 pm Families invited to visit the Akron Children's Museum at Lock 3 in downtown Akron.


3:30 pm Volunteers wrap up projects.

THE NORTH HILL COMMUNITY

The North Hill Community is located north of downtown Akron. The neighborhood developed rapidly in the 1910s and 1920s, and became Akron's preeminent immigrant neighborhood, home to a large Italian and Polish population. Today, it is once again Akron's preeminent immigrant neighborhood, now home to a thriving and growing community of newcomers from Bhutan, Burma, and Nepal. – Jason Segedy, Notes from the Underground.

SENDING SERVICE - 9:00 a.m.

The day begins at 9am at the Akron Civic Theatre. Doors open at 8am. At this 30-minute gathering that will include music and prayer, leaders from the three faith communities will ground us in our work for the day and send us forth in service to God and our neighbors. First Serve t-shirts will be available to pick up in the lobby of the Theatre. A special thank you to Howard Parr and his staff for donating the use of the Akron Civic Theatre.

PARKING

Akron Civic Theatre (Sending Service) Parking: There is a combination of parking lots, parking garages and street parking for the Civic Theatre. The Theatre highly recommends using the Cascade Parking Deck (10 W. Mill Street, Akron), as it is one block north of the Theatre. Other options are outlined on the Akron Civic Theatre website.

Project Parking: Parking opportunities in the North Hill Community will largely depend on your specific project location. Once you register, your project leader will give you specifics closer to the day.

Lock 3 Parking (Free): Lock 3, located in the middle of downtown Akron, is surrounded by several parking decks and a surface lot. The decks include the Summit County Parking Deck on High Street, the O'Neil's Parking Deck on State Street and the Cascade Parking Facility off of Mill Street. Surface lots are located on W. Bowery Street west of Main Street.

First Serve FAQs

Who can participate?

Anyone can participate! Projects are designed for families and people of all ages and abilities. Children can participate with their parents. For the safety of all involved, adults who are working on a project with minors will be background checked. Parents and guardians of minors are asked to complete permission forms for any underage participant.

How can I register?

Registration opens in August at joinfirstserve.org.

What happens if it rains?

This is a rain or shine event.

How will I find out more specific information about my project?

Once you register, your contact information will be sent to your project leader. Your leader will contact you with details closer to the actual date of service. If you have any questions in the meantime, contact Sue Wimer at swimer@hudsonucc.org.

How will I get my project site?

You will receive information from your project leader closer to the date. However, everyone is encouraged to meet at the Akron Civic Theatre for the Sending Service at 9:00 am. Following the service, you will head to the project sites in North Hill.

Do I need to bring supplies to the project site?

In most cases, supplies will be provided. For some projects, you may be asked to bring specific project supplies. Your crew leader will provide details closer to the event date. If there is a specific request, it will be noted in the project description.

What should I wear?

T-shirts are provided for all registered volunteers - please be sure to denote sizing on your registration form. T-shirts will be available at the Akron Civic Theatre on September 8. Please be practical - dress in layers, wear sunscreen and be prepared for a variety of conditions.

Food?

Please bring your own snacks and lunch to the project site. Each crew leader will set aside a time for the crew to take a break and eat lunch together. This is a great way to get to know the people on your crew. All volunteers and residents will be invited to the Lock 3 Celebration Event.
